- Provide Proof of age, ie Birth Certificate or Passport,
- Be available to attend 80% or more of the activities and parade nights conducted by the Army Cadet Unit (ACU) they wish to join,
- Agree to abide by the Australian Army Cadets (AAC) Code of Conduct,
- Complete the application form and all documents required by the AAC & ACU,
- Have their application accepted by 317ACU Officer Commanding
